

# A Report on Swacchata Pakhwada

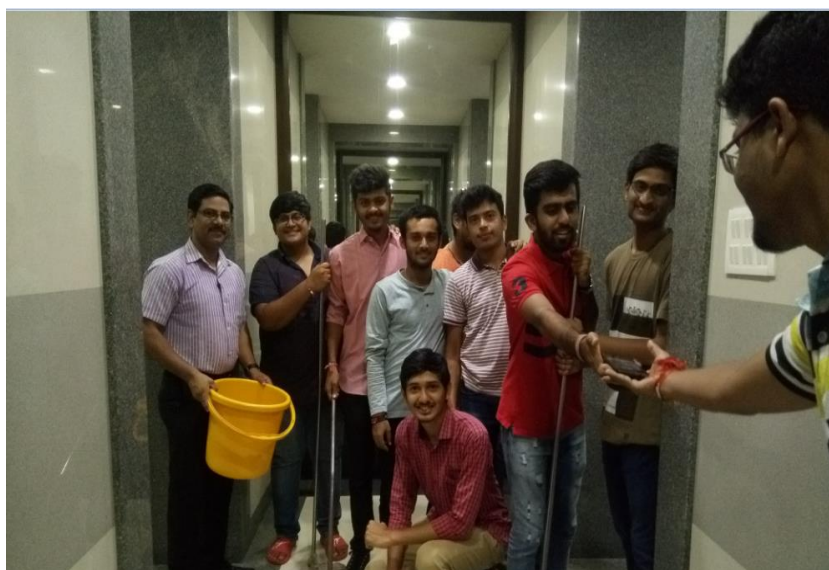
(1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> Sept.)
