Report on the session with the key outcomes (1-2 pages):

'National Education Day' was celebrated by NISP Cell under the aegis of Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) – MPTP Shirpur Campus. The event was organized at R.C. Patel Secondary School, Kharde village, Shirpur on 11th November, 2024. The event was planned with the objective of motivating young students of the school towards innovation and entrepreneurship. The session was also planned to fulfil one of the IIC-NISP objective *viz.*, "Strengthen Innovation Ecosystem: Build a strong innovation culture that encourages creativity and entrepreneurial spirit among students and faculty".

The program featured insightful talks delivered by faculty members from MPTP Shirpur Campus on the following topics:

- 1. Significance of National Education Day Celebration Dr. Mallikarjun Dhotre delivered this particular topic during which he elaborated on National education day is celebrated to honour the birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education minister of independent India; his significant contributions towards Indian education system by establishing AICTE, UGC, IITs and CSIR. It was also discussed on how education is key to progress and why honoring Azad's vision is still relevant today.
- 2. Importance of Education in the Current Era Prof. Rajesh Verma, with his oratory skills, made students to understand importance of education in building our career, overcoming financial hurdles, nation building etc. with stories of various eminent personalities like, Jaykumar Vaidya who raised from the slums of Mumbai to a scientist at NASA, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam etc.





He also encouraged students to see education not just as a means to academic success, but as a tool for self-growth, skill-building, and creating new opportunities

3. Education for Entrepreneurship - Aligned closely with NISP's objectives, this talk by Dr. Rajnish Katarne aimed to spark entrepreneurial thinking among students. He shared insights into how education can be a foundation for innovative ideas, risk-taking, and building businesses that contribute to the economy; he briefed students about the entrepreneurship with an example of Shri. Azim Premji, founder of Wipro whose early life was in Amalner, Dist. Jalgaon a place nearby and very well recognized by the students. He also highlighted on understanding one's own interests and developing career over it.

During these session, the experts were able convince the students to study with dedication as well as participating in extracurricular activities to develop health and wisdom.

At the final phase of the event, there were several queries by the students regarding difficulties in studying, prioritizing sports and studies. It was interesting to note that, the students even asked about the specialization of the experts, difficulties faced during their studies. The questions like what is success? Is getting a job makes one successful? etc. were also asked by the students. Students were also keen to know regarding selection of subjects for enrolling in degree programmes. The teachers of the school who were witnessing the interaction between students and guests expressed their happiness and they were delighted. Overall, it was a lively exchange, with students enthusiastically participating and faculty members offering valuable guidance and encouragement.

As a token of affection, pens were distributed to the student participants and teachers.

The event concluded with vote of thanks. To express gratitude to the school management, a Letter of Appreciation, signed by Director, SVKM's NMIMS, MPTP Shirpur Campus was handed over to the teachers.

Thus, the celebration of National Education Day became more than an event—it was an experience that left a lasting impression on students and strengthened their enthusiasm for innovation and entrepreneurship.
