NMIMS-MPSTME Shirpur Campus conducted a two-day Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Problem and Project-Based Learning from December 12 to 13, 2024.

Dr. Vikas Shinde, Director of the Centre of Excellence in Project-Based Learning (PBL) at Vishwaniketan iMEET, Khalapur, Mumbai University, was the expert speaker for the FDP. More than 40 faculty members from various schools of NMIMS attended the two-day workshop in person. Dr. Atul Dusane and Prof. Pravin Landge from the IT department served as the coordinators for the FDP.

The program provided valuable insights into the principles of problem and project-based learning, including rubric design.
