
(Title of the Event: Stock Market for Dummies)

Event Brief	The Finance Club at NMIMS, Shirpur organized an event on September 28, 2024, in the "C" Wing Seminar Hall, attracting over 150 students. Titled "Stock Market for Dummies," the event aimed to strengthen financial literacy by providing a solid foundation in investing. Three student speakers—Aditya Phatangare, Dhruv Jaiswal, and Nihal Ankam—delivered presentations on key topics such as Initial Public Offerings (IPOs), Systematic Investment Plans (SIPs), Systematic Withdrawal Plans (SWPs), and Mutual Funds. The session's goal was to equip attendees with practical strategies to navigate the complexities of finance, enabling them to make informed investment decisions and manage their finances with confidence. This event aligns with the Finance Club's ongoing mission to promote financial literacy within the student community. Two skits were performed by the Organizing Committee (OC): 1. The Offline Ring at BSE – This skit demonstrated how stock prices fluctuate based on demand and supply, mimicking the live trading floor at the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE), where buyers and sellers engage in intense trading. 2. The Journey of a Tea Seller – This performance depicted a tea seller's rise from a humble street vendor to a successful businessman. Initially, the tea seller approached an angel investor, who provided the seed capital to expand the business. With the investor's support, the tea seller grew his company, eventually launching an Initial Public Offering (IPO) for his company, CCB, and transforming it into a multi-million-dollar enterprise.

Outcomes:

- 1. **Understanding Financial Instruments**: Participants learned about crucial financial tools like SIP, SWP, IPO, and Mutual Funds, giving them a clearer understanding of how to use these instruments for financial planning and investment.
- 2. **Real-life Market Dynamics**: The skits provided a practical demonstration of how market forces such as demand and supply impact stock prices.
- 3. **Importance of Angel Investors**: The portrayal of the tea seller's journey emphasized the role of angel investors in providing start-up capital, enabling entrepreneurs to grow their businesses and eventually launch IPOs.
- 4. **Empowerment through Financial Literacy**: The event empowered students with the confidence to navigate the complex world of finance and investments responsibly.
